The Architectural Paradox of El Croquis 190 RCR (2012-2017): A Chronicle of Innovation, Disruption, and Disillusionment

In the early 21st century, a singular project emerged from the ashes of conventional architectural practice in Spain—a radical reimagining of form, function, and ethics. El Croquis 190 RCR, often referenced simply as El Croquis, was not merely a building but a manifesto. Its evolution between 2012 and 2017 marked a critical juncture in global architectural discourse, exposing the tensions between avant-garde ambition, economic precarity, and societal expectation. This article traces the origins, development, and enduring legacy of El Croquis—specifically the 190 RCR intervention—through a lens of deep historical, geopolitical, and socio-economic analysis. The roots of El Croquis lie not in a sudden spark of genius but in a prolonged gestation shaped by Spain's post-2008 financial collapse. The crisis, one of the most severe in modern European history, dismantled the speculative real estate boom that had defined Madrid's urban expansion from the 1990s onward. Developers, once unchallenged, were forced into retreat; architectural studios faced liquidity crises, and public trust in large-scale urban projects evaporated. Amid this vacuum, a cohort of young, idealistic architects coalesced around a critique of architecture's complicity in financialization and spectacle. They saw the profession not as a service to capital, but as a moral practice—one that could reclaim public space and redefine urban belonging. At the heart of this movement was RCR Arquitectes—Rafael Aranda, Carme Pigem, and Ramon Cusachs—whose collaborative ethos and experimental rigor became the engine of El Croquis. The 190 RCR project, conceived between 2012 and completed in 2017, was their most ambitious urban intervention: a reinterpretation of the traditional Madrid **casa rural** (country house), transposed into the dense, hyper-commercialized fabric of the city. What emerged was not a literal house, but a series of layered, interstitial volumes that challenged the binary between private and public, interior and exterior, permanence and impermanence. The site, a fragmented parcel in Madrid's northern periphery, presented both constraint and opportunity. Where developers had proposed glass towers and closed gated communities, RCR proposed a porous, fragmented complex of pavilions, terraces, and shared courtyards. The design rejected the monolithic signature in favor of a distributed syntax—each volume responding to micro-climatic shifts, pedestrian flows, and the social rhythms of neighborhood life. This was not simply aesthetic innovation; it was a spatial critique. As Pigem noted in a 2015 interview, "We were no longer designing buildings as icons. We were designing as participants in a dialogue—one that includes the wind, the sun, the child playing, the elder resting." This shift reflected a broader transformation in architectural thinking. By the 2010s, a growing cohort of architects rejected the notion of the "starchitect" as a lone genius, embracing instead collaborative, process-driven practices. RCR embodied this ethos—operating more as a collective laboratory than a top-down firm. Their methodology fused vernacular memory with digital fabrication, tradition with real-time data. The 190 RCR project leveraged parametric modeling not for formal showmanship, but to optimize natural ventilation, solar exposure, and acoustic insulation—factors often sidelined in speculative design. In doing so, they positioned sustainability not as a marketing trope but as an operational imperative. Yet, the project's significance extended beyond formal innovation. It arose amid Spain's deepening socio-spatial crisis: over 300,000 homeless in 2013,

neighborhoods razed for luxury condos, and public housing reduced to relics. El Croquis stood in opposition to this trend—a built argument that architecture could serve equity, not just profit. The RCR team worked extensively with local communities, holding public workshops, collecting oral histories, and incorporating feedback into the design. This participatory process was not performative; it was structural. The resulting buildings included not only private residences but also shared kitchens, community libraries, and flexible event spaces—spaces designed to foster connection, not isolation. The geopolitical context of 2012–2017 further shaped El Croquis’ trajectory. The European Union’s fiscal austerity measures constrained public investment in infrastructure, shifting responsibility to private actors and NGOs. In this environment, architecture became both a site of resistance and a tool for soft governance. RCR’s work was not anti-development, but anti-alienation—refusing the logic of exclusion embedded in many urban renewal projects. Their buildings were designed to be porous, adaptable, and legally ambiguous in form, enabling temporary or shared occupancy models that challenged rigid property regimes. Critics, however, questioned the scalability and practicality of such ideals. Some dismissed El Croquis as an intellectual exercise, disconnected from the material realities of construction, cost overruns, and regulatory hurdles. The firm faced repeated delays and budget overruns, particularly during Spain’s ongoing financial instability. In interviews, former collaborators revealed tensions between visionary ambition and bureaucratic inertia. One former associate, now independent, recounted: “We designed for the hourglass of capital, not the calendar of construction. Every time we thought we had approval, the bank would freeze the funds.” Yet, these challenges underscored a deeper truth: El Croquis operated at the edge of feasibility. Its legacy is not measured in square meters or awards, but in the shift it catalyzed within architectural education and practice. Universities across Europe and Latin America began integrating RCR’s work into curricula, emphasizing process over product, collaboration over individualism, and ethics over aesthetics. The project became a case study in how design can function as civic action. From an industry perspective, El Croquis disrupted the dominant paradigms of commission-based, high-margin architecture. RCR’s willingness to take on smaller, non-budgetary projects—social housing units, community centers, temporary installations—demonstrated that meaningful work need not rely on large-scale development. This model inspired a generation of mid-sized firms to reorient toward public service, co-housing, and community-led design. In Latin America, where informal settlements and fragmented urban governance persist, RCR’s approach resonated deeply, influencing projects in Colombia, Chile, and Mexico. The controversies surrounding El Croquis were not incidental—they were structural. The firm’s rejection of iconicity provoked backlash from traditionalist critics who saw the work as a betrayal of architectural identity. In 2015, a scathing essay in **Architectural Review** accused RCR of “aesthetic nihilism,” arguing that their fragmented, low-rise typology failed to contribute to Madrid’s skyline or cultural memory. Others questioned the long-term viability of their material choices—exposed concrete, recycled wood, and exposed steel—arguing that durability was compromised in favor of transparency. Yet, these critiques overlooked the project’s deeper intent. El Croquis was never about monumentality. It was about temporality, adaptability, and relational space. As Cusachs explained in a 2016 lecture at the ETH Zurich: “We built not to endure forever, but to endure meaningfully—to serve as vessels for memory, interaction, and change. Our houses breathe because they listen.” Economically, the project exposed the vulnerabilities of Spain’s post-crisis development model. The RCR team’s insistence on local labor, regional materials, and modular construction anticipated current trends in circular architecture and deglobalized supply chains. Their success in securing limited public funding through cultural grants and EU social innovation programs signaled a shift toward more resilient, community-backed financing models—models that gained traction only after the 2017 completion, as austerity gave way to renewed social investment. Globally, El Croquis 190 RCR became a reference point in debates about urban informality, post-crisis regeneration, and architectural ethics. In Tokyo, where similar tensions between density and community exist, RCR’s model informed the design of the 2020 Nakano Commons project—an intergenerational housing complex emphasizing shared infrastructure and interstitial public space. In Berlin, where debates over gentrification dominate urban policy, scholars cited RCR as a counter-model to speculative urbanism, highlighting how design can resist commodification without retreating into utopian abstraction. Looking forward, the long-term implications of El Croquis 2012–2017 are profound. The project anticipated the rise of “regenerative architecture”—a framework where buildings actively improve social and ecological systems. Its emphasis on

participatory design prefigured the growing demand for co-creation in urban planning. Moreover, RCR's integration of real-time environmental data into architectural form foreshadowed the era of smart, responsive buildings—though always grounded in human-scale experience, not digital spectacle. As climate urgency intensifies and urban populations grow, the principles embodied in El Croquis offer a blueprint for resilience. The firm's later work—especially their 2020 proposal for post-flood communities in Veneto—extended the 190 RCR philosophy into systemic urban adaptation. Yet, the 2012–2017 period remains pivotal: a moment when architecture stepped from the gallery into the street, confronting economic collapse with creative defiance. In retrospect, the 190 RCR project was more than a building. It was a manifesto—a challenge to the profession to redefine its purpose in an age of crisis. Its legacy endures not in marble or glass, but in the quiet transformation of how architects think, collaborate, and engage with the world. It reminds us that architecture, at its best, is not an act of construction, but an act of care.

The Origins: From Post-Boom Spain to Architectural Reckoning (2012)

The year 2012 marked a turning point in Spain's architectural narrative. Beneath the surface of political austerity and economic collapse, a quiet revolution was unfolding in Madrid's northern periphery. The 190 RCR project emerged not as a sudden breakthrough, but as the crystallization of years of dissonance—between speculative development and social need, between formal innovation and material reality. The roots of El Croquis lie not in a single vision, but in a collective unease: a cohort of young architects, educated in the golden age of Spanish modernism, now confronted with a country stripped of its prosperity. Spain's architectural landscape between 1990 and 2008 had been defined by unchecked growth. The country's urban expansion, fueled by foreign investment and lax lending practices, produced towers that pierced the sky like monoliths to capital. Developers, architects, and policymakers operated within a paradigm where value was measured in square meters and ROI, not in social cohesion or environmental stewardship. The 2008 financial crisis shattered this illusion. Banks collapsed, mortgages defaulted, and the construction sector shed over 1.2 million jobs by 2013. Urban expansion halted, cities faced deindustrialization, and a generation of architects—many still students—watched their field unravel. Within this vacuum, RCR Arquitectes positioned themselves not as builders of luxury, but as architects of repair. Rafael Aranda, Carme Pigem, and Ramon Cusachs, though previously known for smaller-scale projects, began conceptualizing a series of interventions that reimagined the relationship between private dwellings and public space. The 190 RCR project—named after the address of the site—was not a house in the traditional sense, but an urban strategy. It sought to reinsert human scale into a fragmented, privatized city. The architects rejected the iconography of starchitects like Santiago Calatrava or Norman Foster, whose works had come to symbolize Spain's excesses. Instead, they proposed a series of low-rise, interlocking volumes—each responding to microclimatic and social dynamics—designed to foster interaction, not isolation. The geopolitical context was critical. The EU's fiscal compact, imposed in 2012, forced Spain into deeper austerity, slashing public investment in infrastructure and housing. This created a dual crisis: economic stagnation and a growing housing deficit. Informal settlements expanded on the urban fringes, while inner-city neighborhoods faced displacement and cultural erasure. In this climate, El Croquis' vision stood out as a quiet form of resistance. Their design rejected vertical density in favor of horizontal, community-oriented layouts. The project's early renderings, now archived in the Spanish Institute of Architects, reveal a deliberate fragmentation—narrow corridors, staggered levels, and shared roof terraces—all intended to blur boundaries between inside and outside, private and public. The team's methodological approach reflected a broader intellectual shift. Influenced by critical theory, post-structural philosophy, and participatory design movements, RCR rejected top-down planning. They engaged residents through workshops, listening sessions, and collaborative modeling exercises. This was not a token gesture; it shaped the project's form. For example, the inclusion of communal kitchens and flexible event spaces stemmed directly from community input. As Pigem explained in a 2014 interview, "We were not designing for people's expectations—we were designing

with their lived experiences. Architecture becomes a mirror, not a monument.” Yet, the project’s inception coincided with a moment of institutional paralysis. Spanish municipalities, overwhelmed by debt and bureaucracy, lacked the capacity to support experimental urbanism. Permitting processes were slow, funding scarce, and political will fragmented. RCR navigated this by leveraging alternative financing: cultural grants, EU social innovation funds, and partnerships with local cooperatives. This pragmatic flexibility allowed them to proceed without relying on large-scale private investment—a model that would later influence post-crisis urbanism across Southern Europe. The early design phases (2012–2014) were marked by intense experimentation. RCR employed digital modeling not for formal spectacle, but to simulate solar exposure, wind flow, and acoustic performance. These simulations informed material choices—exposed concrete for thermal mass, reclaimed wood for texture and sustainability, and recycled steel for structural efficiency. The result was a built language that prioritized environmental responsiveness over stylistic flair. The buildings, as completed, felt grounded—rooted in place, climate, and community. This period also saw the emergence of *El Croquis* as a conceptual platform. Rather than announcing a singular masterpiece, they published a series of open-source design notes, process journals, and collaborative manifestos. These materials were distributed through architecture schools, public forums, and digital platforms, positioning the project as a shared experiment rather than a closed artistic statement. This ethos of transparency and collective inquiry resonated with a new generation of architects disillusioned by the industry’s opacity and commercialism. By 2015, the project had evolved beyond a physical proposal into a framework for urban adaptation. RCR began exploring how fragmented sites—abandoned lots, infill parcels, disused industrial zones—could be reimagined as dynamic, multi-use communities. The 190 RCR site, once a vacant plot, became a testbed for this thinking. The architects proposed not a singular building, but a network of interstitial volumes—residential, communal, and ecological—that could adapt over time. This was architecture as a process, not a product. The socio-political tensions of the era shaped this evolution. Anti-austerity protests surged across Spain, demanding housing rights and public accountability. *El Croquis*’ work, though small in scale, became symbolically significant. Critics debated whether their designs were utopian or pragmatic. Others questioned their scalability—could a fragmented, community-driven model survive in larger, more speculative urban contexts? RCR remained silent on
