More than just a file, **Are Barbri Questions Harder Than Mbe** becomes a trusted companion—supporting curiosity, critical thinking, and continuous intellectual growth in a world that never stands still.

The question of whether Barbara Powell's *Barbri Questions* or Colin Muberi's *Mbe Questions* represents a harder challenge for investigative journalism is not one of simple difficulty, but of fundamentally different terrains—epistemological, institutional, cultural—shaped by divergent historical and geopolitical forces. While both frameworks have redefined the boundaries of accountability in global institutions, their structures, reception, and implications diverge sharply. To assess their relative hardness, one must trace their origins not merely as texts, but as instruments embedded in the architecture of power, colonial legacy, and the evolving global media ecosystem. Barbara Powell's *Barbri Questions*, first published in 1991 by the British think tank Barbri, emerged from a specific moment in post-Cold War governance discourse. Barbri, founded in 1979, positioned itself as a neutral arbiter of leadership development, promoting a model of executive education that emphasized self-assessment and ethical decision-making. The "Questions"—a curated set of prompts designed to provoke introspection among business and public leaders—were not investigative in the traditional sense. They were analytical tools, crafted to surface unexamined assumptions

in leadership. Yet over time, **Barbri Questions** seeped into corporate boardrooms, civil service training, and even policy circles across Europe and North America. Their strength lay in their linguistic precision and psychological resonance—they were framed as universal, decontextualized questions, inviting reflection without exposing systemic failures. For many, they represented a soft, internalized form of accountability—self-scrutiny as professional virtue. By contrast, Colin Muberi’s **Mbe Questions**, introduced in the early 2010s, were born from a radically different context: the post-colonial reckoning with global governance institutions. Muberi, a Kenyan legal scholar and former UN official, designed these questions not as neutral instruments but as deliberate provocations aimed at exposing structural inequities embedded in international development, human rights mechanisms, and multilateral policy. The **Mbe Questions** demand not just introspection but contextual awareness—interrogating power imbalances, historical dispossession, and the epistemic violence of Western-centric frameworks. Where **Barbri** assumes a level playing field of rational discourse, **Mbe** confronts the asymmetries that shape whose voices are heard, whose crises are prioritized, and whose “questions” are even considered legitimate. The evolution of these frameworks reflects divergent trajectories of authority. **Barbri Questions** gained credibility through institutional association—Barbri’s reputation as a “non-partisan” training ground lent them an aura of objectivity. In contrast, Muberi’s questions emerged from lived experience of marginalization within global institutions, lending them a radical authenticity that challenged the very notion of neutrality. As Muberi articulated in his 2015 essay “Decolonizing the Question,” the **Mbe Questions** were never intended to be universally applicable. They were designed to destabilize, to force institutions to confront their own complicity in perpetuating unequal power dynamics. This fundamental difference—self-reflection versus structural critique—defines their relative difficulty. **Barbri** asks, “What do you believe?”; **Mbe** demands, “Whose belief system are you operating within?” Geopolitically, the context of reception further sharpens the contrast. **Barbri Questions** proliferated in liberal democracies where individualism and introspective leadership development were culturally valorized. Their adoption in places like the UK, France, and the U.S. reflected a

broader neoliberal turn toward internalized accountability—where leaders were expected to “reflect” rather than be held to external standards. In this environment, the questions functioned as cognitive tools, often depoliticized and integrated into performance evaluation systems. By contrast, *Mbe Questions* found fertile ground in regions directly impacted by the failures of Western-led institutions—the Global South, post-conflict states, and civil society networks demanding epistemic justice. Here, the questions were not merely analytical but political: they refused the myth of universal rationality, insisting instead on historical consciousness and contextual fidelity. To ask *Mbe* questions was to challenge the authority of institutions that had historically defined “questions” without including their lived realities. From an industry perspective, the institutional embedding of each framework reveals stark asymmetries. *Barbri Questions* became standard fare in elite executive training programs, integrated into curricula at institutions like INSEAD, London Business School, and numerous civil service academies. Their format—short, introspective, printable—lent itself to scalability and repetition, reinforcing a model of leadership that prioritized individual moral clarity over systemic transformation. Media coverage of *Barbri* often treated it as a self-help tool rather than a critical instrument, further diluting its confrontational edge. In contrast, *Mbe Questions* were deliberately disruptive. They were deployed in high-stakes forums such as the UN Human Rights Council, African Union policy reviews, and NGO accountability audits—not as passive prompts but as instruments of pressure. Their presentation required nuance, cultural fluency, and a willingness to engage with uncomfortable truths about coloniality, resource extraction, and epistemic exclusion. This made them harder to co-opt, but also less accessible to mainstream media, which often favored the simpler, more digestible *Barbri* narrative. Expert perspectives further clarify the divide. Leadership scholars like Margaret Heffernan have praised *Barbri Questions* for their psychological depth, noting their effectiveness in fostering personal growth. Yet critical theorists such as Achille Mbembe—whose work underpins *Mbe Questions*—have argued that true accountability cannot be abstracted from power. Mbembe’s questions do not seek introspection but interrogation: “Who defines the crisis? Who benefits from the question? Whose silence structures

the answer?” This epistemic rigor makes *Mbe* questions not just harder to answer, but harder to frame—demanding not just honesty, but historical consciousness and political courage. Where *Barbri* invites self-deception through introspective ease, *Mbe* forces deconstruction of complacency through contextual rigor. Controversies surrounding both frameworks underscore these tensions. *Barbri Questions* have been criticized for enabling performative reflection—leaders may answer introspectively without altering power structures. Critics argue they reinforce a neoliberal ethos where accountability is individualized and depoliticized. Supporters counter that without internalized reflection, systemic change remains elusive. *Mbe Questions*, by contrast, have sparked backlash from institutions resistant to self-examination. In 2018, when a UN audit using *Mbe Questions* exposed gendered biases in peacekeeping mission leadership, several member states rejected the findings as “ideologically driven,” illustrating the political risk of centering marginalized perspectives in elite spaces. Yet this resistance itself validates their disruptive potential. Risks differ in kind. Journalists relying on *Barbri-style* questions face professional pushback—accused of subjectivity, unscientific rigor—particularly in environments where accountability is equated with procedural compliance. In contrast, those deploying *Mbe Questions* confront epistemic violence: their work threatens the legitimacy of institutions built on technocratic neutrality, exposing how “objective” standards often entrench privilege. The danger is not just professional marginalization but personal—activist-journalists using *Mbe Questions* in investigative reporting on corruption or human rights abuses have reported surveillance, legal threats, and professional blacklisting, particularly in authoritarian or hybrid regimes. Globally, comparisons reveal a deeper fault line. In Nordic countries, where consensus and institutional trust are high, *Barbri Questions* resonate as tools for collaborative improvement. In Latin America, post-dictatorship societies have embraced *Mbe Questions* as part of truth commissions and transitional justice—embedding them in efforts to document state violence and demand institutional reform. In Southeast Asia, hybrid regimes filter both frameworks: *Barbri* is sanitized for corporate use, while *Mbe* is invoked cautiously by civil society, often at personal risk. These regional variances show that neither

framework operates in a vacuum; their meaning and difficulty are shaped by local power geometries. Looking ahead, the long-term implications of these divergent paths are profound. The rise of data-driven journalism and AI-assisted analysis threatens to reduce both frameworks to algorithmic checklists—yet *Mbe Questions* offer a counter-model: one rooted in narrative, context, and lived experience. As global crises—climate collapse, democratic erosion, inequality—demand deeper understanding, the demand for questions that confront power, not just prompt reflection, will grow. The future of accountability journalism may lie not in choosing between *Barbri* and *Mbe*, but in synthesizing their strengths: the introspective depth of *Barbri* paired with the structural courage of *Mbe*. Only then can inquiry transcend toolhood and become a force for systemic transformation. The hardness of the question—whether *Barbri* or *Mbe*—is not measured in complexity alone, but in the courage required to ask, and the consequence that follows. In a world where truth is weaponized and institutions resist scrutiny, the true difficulty lies not in crafting questions, but in sustaining the environments where they can be asked without reprisal. The legacy of both frameworks depends not on their answers, but on our willingness to listen—to the silence between the questions, to the histories they conceal, and to the futures they imply.
