reconnection—resonated not only in Scandinavia but in societies grappling with historical wounds, economic precarity, and the psychological toll of digital isolation. It emerged from a confluence of geopolitical and cultural conditions: rising anxiety over mental health in high-functioning societies, the destabilization of traditional support systems, and a hunger for narratives that acknowledge pain without succumbing to despair.
