AI chatbots designed for customer service or companionship often mimic youthful voices, reinforcing the expectation that youth is synonymous with modernity, efficiency, and relevance. The advertising industry, too, exploits the **puer aeternus** fantasy. Campaigns targeting “ageless” beauty, “forever young” skincare, and “timeless” fashion sell not products, but participation in perpetual youth. A 2022 McKinsey study revealed that global beauty spending tied to “aging reversal” reached \$48 billion, with 73% of consumers aged 18–35 citing “youthful appearance” as a top priority. These campaigns do not sell products—they sell identity, promising that eternal youth is both attainable and desirable. Even journalism and media narratives contribute. Outlets chase “next-gen” storytellers, framing youth as the future of innovation, while veterans are sidelined as “out of touch.” This reinforces a generational hierarchy where age equates to irrelevance, further entrenching the **puer aeternus** as a cultural ideal.

Expert Perspectives: The Psychological and Sociological Divide Scholars and clinicians debate the **puer aeternus** not as a singular phenomenon, but as a spectrum—ranging from adaptive resilience to pathological evasion.
