No explanation. That moment crystallized her understanding: faith, when divorced from transparency, becomes a system of control, not compassion. This dissonance deepened during her seminary years. Though ordained in 2008, she never celebrated Mass publicly. Instead, she taught Sunday theology at a small parish in Arlington, Virginia, to a small group of parishioners—none of whom knew her full story. There, she witnessed firsthand how ritual, when disconnected from ethical accountability, could reinforce hierarchies rather than serve them. The sacraments remained, but their meaning was hollowed by silence. Freedom’s departure from the priesthood in 2012 was not a sudden decision, but a slow unraveling. She later wrote in a private journal (now cited in her 2017 exposé): “I believed in the Church’s mission, but not its mechanisms. To be a priest was to serve, not to command.” Her resignation letter to Bishop Joseph Kurtz—quiet, unassailable—was not an indictment of God, but of institutional failure. It cited “a growing incompatibility between personal conscience and institutional practice,” a phrase that would become her signature. That letter, leaked months later, triggered a firestorm. Conservatives decried it as betrayal; progressives saw it as courage. The Vatican’s official response—“the priesthood remains a sacred vocation”—did not address the underlying question: how can a vocation survive when its structures ensure its own protection? Freedom’s subsequent retreat into anonymity was not avoidance, but investigation. She moved to Berlin, then Lisbon, working freelance while documenting abuse cases across Europe and the U.S. Her fieldwork revealed a pattern: sexual mis
