Duigan acknowledged this, advocating for policy levers: subsidies redirected from processed foods to whole agriculture, urban farming initiatives, and food education embedded in school curricula. He often cited Brazil's **Programa Nacional de Alimentação Escolar** as a model—where local procurement reduced costs while boosting nutritional quality. By 2017, Clean Lean had evolved into a transdisciplinary framework. Duigan co-founded the Clean
