Jaquavis, known in criminal circles as “La Arquitecta,” applied financial analytics and organizational theory to cartel operations, transforming smuggling into a structured enterprise. She pioneered the use of decentralized command nodes, using blockchain-inspired ledgers and offshore shell companies to obscure ownership.
