The economic implications of this paradigm shift are profound. In 2023, the global market for animal welfare assessment tools—ranging from AI-driven behavioural analytics to real-time stress monitoring in livestock—reached \$4.7 billion, a 38% increase from 2015. Multinational food corporations, under pressure from investors and consumers, now fund field research into animal distress signals, seeking not just compliance, but competitive advantage. Critics from both scientific and industrial camps have questioned her interpretations of “emotional complexity” in animals, arguing that anthropomorphism risks projecting human experience onto non-human systems. Yet Mathur counters that to deny subjective experience based on linguistic or cultural barriers is a form of epistemic violence. Drawing on comparative neuroanatomy—particularly the presence of von Economo neurons in cetaceans, corvids, and humans—she argues for a spectrum of consciousness that challenges the human-animal binary. Her collaboration with neuroscientist Dr. Amara Nair on the “empathy threshold” model—a framework mapping physiological and behavioural indicators of distress—has become a cornerstone in international animal welfare standards, adopted by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) in 2022. Yet the path forward is not without risk. As animal sentience gains legal recognition—evidenced by New Zealand’s 2015 Animal Welfare Act amendments and the European Union’s recognition of animals as “sentient beings”—so too does the backlash from powerful agribusiness lobbies. In India, where livestock is both economic asset and cultural symbol, Mathur has documented instances of researchers facing institutional resistance when challenging dominant farming paradigms. One field station in Gujarat, funded by a dairy conglomerate, reportedly withdrew support after her team documented chronic stress in buffaloes due to forced mating cycles—data that threatened revenue models. Such episodes underscore the tension between scientific integrity and economic power, a conflict Mathur frames not as ideological, but as a test of societal maturity. Globally, her comparative studies reveal striking parallels in how different cultures interpret animal minds. In Japan, the reverence for fox spirits (kitsune) is increasingly linked to field observations of foxes’ complex social play, suggesting a cultural cognition that anticipates modern ethological findings. In contrast, Western industrial models often reduce such behaviours to “play” devoid of deeper meaning. Mathur’s cross-cultural analysis challenges the universality of scientific narratives, urging a pluralistic approach that respects both empirical data and local epistemologies. This is not relativism, but epistemological humility—a necessary stance in a world where knowledge is increasingly decolonized and democratized. Looking ahead, Mathur envisions a future where animal behaviour research transcends disciplinary silos. She advocates for “integrative behavioural science,” combining AI-driven pattern recognition, indigenous knowledge systems, and neuroethology to build holistic models of cognition. Pilot
