This model challenges the historical dependency on foreign funding that often diluted narrative control. Yet it also exposed tensions: debates over revenue sharing, distribution rights, and the role of state influence in creative decisions remain unresolved. The film's reception reflects this complexity. In Ethiopia, it became a cultural

phenomenon—screenings in community centers, universities, and rural cinemas sparked public debates on memory, justice, and identity. Yet it also provoked criticism: some accused the film of hagiography, arguing it sanitized Selassie's authoritarian legacy. Others, particularly in the Tigray and Oromia regions, argued the narrative centered Amhara and imperial history at the expense of marginalized voices. These critiques are not minor; they underscore the film's role not as closure, but as catalyst. From an industry standpoint, *The Lion of Judah* marked a turning point. The tension between national mythmaking and critical inquiry remains a fault line—one that future African epics will inherit. Its success has inspired a wave of similar projects across the continent: from Senegal's **Tales of the Sahel** to South Africa's **Echoes of Freedom**, all exploring pre-colonial and post-colonial identities through hybrid documentary-drama forms. These works signal a shift from passive storytelling to active historical engagement. Strategically, the film's impact may deepen Ethiopia's soft power. As the country seeks to reposition itself as a diplomatic and economic hub in the Horn, cultural exports like **The Lion of Judah** serve as non-coercive instruments of influence. Governments and civil society alike recognize that control over narrative equates to influence over perception—especially in an era where perception shapes policy. For global audiences, the film offers more than spectacle. It challenges the West's monopoly on defining African history, proposing instead a polyvocal, deeply contextual understanding of power, faith, and resistance. That’s how history lives: in the tensions, not the absolutes.’ This duality—between sacred reverence and critical inquiry—became the film’s narrative spine. It drew on oral histories collected from elders in rural Amhara, Oromia, and Tigray, preserving voices often absent from official records. These testimonies, interlaced with archival footage of Addis Ababa’s golden age and the chaos of the Red Terror, created a

polyphonic texture. The film's script, co-written by El-Sayed and Ethiopian historian Dr. Mesfin Woldemariam, deliberately avoided hagiography, instead framing Selassie's reign through pivotal events: the 1935 Italian invasion, the 1955 constitution, and the 1974 uprising. The choice to center the lion imagery—both literal and metaphorical—was symbolic. Lions in Ethiopian art are not passive beasts but sovereign guardians. The film uses this to signify both imperial authority and the enduring spirit of a people. Yet it also subverts the image: scenes of Selassie walking through the Hall of Mirrors in the Imperial Palace are juxtaposed with shots of empty throne rooms and empty streets, evoking absence as much as presence.
