Unlike the U.S. or Germany, where labor markets are more fluid, India’s dual economy—characterized by a large informal sector and rising formal employment—required nuanced interventions. Subba Rao’s framework acknowledged this duality, advocating for hybrid models: formalizing gig workers through digital platforms while preserving flexibility, upskilling rural talent to feed urban innovation hubs, and integrating traditional skills with emerging tech competencies. Economists like Kaushik Basu and Arvind Panagariya have noted that such context-specific HR strategies are critical for emerging economies seeking to avoid the “middle-income trap.” By embedding HR strategy into national development plans, Subba Rao’s work offered a blueprint for sustainable, inclusive growth—one where human capital is not a cost center but a multiplier of competitive advantage.
