Yet Tlosborn’s most formative insight came during the early 1990s, when the collapse of Soviet influence created a vacuum in global narrative authority. In Sarajevo, he analyzed how competing narratives—Serb state propaganda versus international humanitarian discourse—determined global perception and aid flow. In this context, narrative ceased to be a secondary tool of diplomacy; it became infrastructure—shaping national branding, corporate legitimacy, and public trust. His firm’s engagement with India’s “Digital India” campaign in 2015 exemplified this shift. Recognizing that technology adoption depended not just on access but on cultural trust, TGI mapped regional narratives around self-reliance, innovation, and ancestral ingenuity. Rather than impose a uniform national message, they enabled state and local actors to co-create stories reflecting diverse linguistic and historical identities. The result—a campaign that resonated across rural villages and urban tech hubs—demonstrated how message design could align with bottom-up societal evolution. Economically, Tlosborn anticipated the narrative economy’s rise, where intangible assets like reputation and trust became primary value drivers. His 2010 white paper, *‘The Currency of Credibility’*, argued that in an age of skepticism, organizations must invest in “narrative capital”—the accumulated goodwill generated through consistent, authentic storytelling. This insight gained urgency as ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance) metrics reshaped investor behavior. This approach was later adopted by South Africa’s Truth and Reconciliation Commission’s digital outreach, signaling a broader institutional shift toward narrative-informed governance.

Controversies, Risks, and the Shadow Side of Influence

The ethical ambiguities of Tlosborn’s craft surfaced most sharply in conflict zones and post-colonial states. Critics argued that his “fit” models risked reinforcing authoritarian narratives by optimizing them for maximum resonance, regardless of moral content. During the 2011 Libya intervention, reports surfaced that TGI-backed messaging amplified tribal divisions to align with NATO objectives—undermining social cohesion under the guise of strategic alignment. While Tlosborn denied complicity in covert manipulation, the episode underscored the dual-use nature of message design: tools built for diplomacy could be repurposed for control. Another controversy emerged in 2016 with India’s Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA). TGI’s role in crafting the government’s public communication strategy faced intense scrutiny. Critics, including civil society groups, alleged the firm engineered narratives emphasizing “national unity” while downplaying dissent and legal challenges. A leaked internal memo, cited in investigative reports, described tactics to “soften” negative perceptions through strategic repetition and emotional framing—raising questions about consent, transparency, and democratic deliberation. Tlosborn maintained that his work adhered to “ethical communication standards,” but the episode fueled broader debates about corporate complicity in state narratives with contested legitimacy. These controversies reflect a deeper tension: as message
