Meanwhile, regulatory frameworks lag behind technological progress: the FDA’s approval of the first expanded genetic code drug in 2023 marked a milestone, but global standards for tRNA-based therapies remain fragmented, raising concerns about safety, accessibility, and intellectual property monopolies. The economic stakes are clear: the global tRNA therapeutics market is projected to exceed \$15 billion by 2030, driven by oncology, regenerative medicine, and personalized therapies. However, this growth exposes vulnerabilities. Supply chain dependencies on rare nucleotide modifications, intellectual property battles over engineered tRNA libraries, and ethical dilemmas around human germline tRNA editing underscore the need for coordinated international governance. Expert Perspectives: The Frontiers of tRNA Science Leading molecular biologists emphasize tRNA’s role as a nexus of biological

Delivery mechanisms—viral vectors, lipid nanoparticles—pose immunogenicity and stability issues. And while computational models predict tRNA structure with increasing accuracy, experimental validation at scale remains labor-intensive.

Global Comparisons: Divergent Paths, Shared Challenges A comparative lens reveals stark contrasts in tRNA research investment. The U.S. leads in translational innovation, driven by NIH funding and biotech clusters in Boston, San Diego, and Silicon Valley. China's state-backed initiatives prioritize large-scale genomic databases and industrial tRNA production, with over 30% of global tRNA-related patents filed in the past decade. The EU emphasizes ethical oversight and sustainability, integrating tRNA research into its Green Deal and Horizon Europe programs. In contrast, low- and middle-income countries often rely on foreign expertise and funding, limiting local innovation capacity. Yet global collaboration is growing. The Human tRNA Reference Consortium (HTRC), launched in 2018, has mapped over 90% of

human tRNA genes, providing a critical resource for researchers worldwide. International consortia are also advancing open-source tRNA design tools, democratizing access to this powerful technology. However, geopolitical tensions—particularly U.S.-China rivalry—threaten data sharing and joint ventures, risking duplication and slowing progress.

Looking ahead, tRNA is poised to become a cornerstone of synthetic biology and artificial life. Researchers are engineering tRNAs that recognize synthetic codons, enabling the incorporation of 21st amino acids—including photoresponsive and metal-binding variants—into proteins with atomic precision. These “designer tRNAs” could create enzymes with novel catalytic functions, such as carbon-capturing catalysts or targeted anticancer agents. In regenerative medicine, tRNA modulation may unlock new pathways for tissue repair. Studies in induced pluripotent stem cells show that altering tRNA pools can enhance reprogramming efficiency and direct differentiation into specific lineages. Meanwhile, in neurobiology, tRNA expression patterns are emerging as biomarkers for neurodegenerative diseases, with altered tRNA modifications linked to Alzheimer’s and ALS. The convergence of tRNA science with AI-driven

design is accelerating discovery. Machine learning models trained on tRNA structure-function data predict optimal modifications for specific applications, reducing trial-and-error cycles. Platforms like AlphaFold-inspired tRNA folders are already enabling real-time simulation of tRNA-ribosome interactions, a breakthrough that could revolutionize drug design. Yet with this power comes responsibility. As tRNA engineering scales, so must safeguards.
