State-owned enterprises (SOEs) were pressured to meet financial targets not just for profit, but as moral proof of service to national development. Private firms, emerging from the reform era, adopted similar metrics, embedding efficiency and loyalty into corporate codes.

This evolution was never without contradiction. As China integrated into global supply chains, its ethical posture was scrutinized abroad. Western critics decried labor rights violations, environmental negligence, and state surveillance as moral failures. Yet within China, these tensions were reframed: state oversight was framed as ethical protection, not oppression; data governance as social security. Pohl documents how this dissonance shaped China’s foreign ethical narrative—one that rejects universalist human rights frameworks in favor of “contextual morality,” where development, stability, and sovereignty precede individual liberal freedoms.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: Ethics as Instrument of Power

China’s global economic rise—from “the

factory of the world” to a leader in AI, green energy, and digital infrastructure—has transformed ethics from domestic concern to geopolitical instrument. Pohl analyzes how ethical discourse serves strategic ends: China’s Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), for instance, is not merely economic but moralized as “win-win cooperation,” a counter-narrative to Western neocolonialism. Projects are justified not only by return on investment but by shared civilizational destiny—a Confucian-inspired vision of harmony across nations. Yet this moral framing carries risks. As Pohl details, China’s export of governance models—such as social credit systems and digital surveillance—raises global ethical questions. While Chinese officials and scholars defend these tools as instruments of social trust and public order, critics in Europe and the

Americas decry authoritarian overreach. Pohl argues this reflects a deeper epistemological divide: China's ethics emphasize collective stability and state stewardship, whereas Western frameworks prioritize individual autonomy and transparency. The result is a moral friction that complicates diplomacy, trade, and investment. Economically, Chinese corporate ethics evolved under dual pressure: global compliance standards (like ESG reporting) and domestic imperatives. Multinational firms operating in China, from Volkswagen to Tesla, navigate a labyrinth where legal compliance may not suffice—ethical legitimacy demands alignment with local norms. Pohl's interviews with foreign CEOs in Shanghai reveal a pervasive awareness: failure to “read the room” ethically—respecting hierarchical relationships, avoiding public criticism of

officials, adapting communication styles—can undermine market access and political goodwill.

This adaptive pragmatism, however, is not without internal strain. As China’s middle class grows and civil society cautiously asserts itself, demands for ethical accountability expand. Environmental activism, labor advocacy, and calls for legal transparency challenge the state’s narrative of benevolent stewardship. Pohl documents a quiet but significant shift: younger officials and entrepreneurs increasingly invoke ethical language tied to sustainability, fairness, and innovation—not just loyalty or growth.

Industry Impact: Ethical Norms as Competitive Advantage

Within China’s industrial sectors, ethical conduct has become a strategic differentiator. In manufacturing, for example, firms that prioritize worker welfare, environmental compliance, and quality control gain competitive edge both domestically and abroad.

The rise of “green factories” in Guangdong and Jiangsu, compliant with EU carbon standards, reflects this trend. Pohl

highlights how such practices are not merely defensive—avoiding sanctions—but proactive, enhancing brand equity in global markets. In the tech sector, the ethical calculus is more fraught. Companies like Huawei and Tencent operate in a gray zone where innovation is celebrated but state influence is undeniable. Pohl’s investigation reveals a dual ethical posture: outwardly, firms emphasize corporate social responsibility, R&D transparency, and consumer privacy; inwardly, alignment with national strategic goals—cybersecurity, digital sovereignty, and technological self-reliance—shapes operational ethics. This duality, Pohl argues, is not hypocrisy but a sophisticated adaptation: ethical branding enables global reach, while state coordination ensures long-term strategic coherence. Pohl also examines the financial sector, where ESG investing is gaining traction but remains constrained by political priorities. Chinese banks and asset managers increasingly publish sustainability reports, yet ethical lending decisions are still influenced by industrial policy. State-directed credit allocation often overrides market risk assessments—a reflection of ethics fused with political economy.

This sectoral complexity underscores a broader reality: Chinese ethics in industry are not monolithic but differentiated by market logic, regulatory environment, and geopolitical exposure. Firms that master this landscape do so by balancing global ethical expectations with domestic imperatives—a tightrope walk that

defines China's industrial ascent.

Expert Perspectives: Scholars, Officials, and the Critique of “Chinese Ethics”

Pohl's work resonates with a growing cohort of Chinese and international scholars who challenge both Western moral absolutism and state propaganda. Economist Justin Lin, former World Bank chief economist and advocate of “developmental state” models, praises Pohl for revealing how China's ethics are rooted in pragmatic statecraft rather than ideological purity. Lin argues this flexibility enables resilience in volatile global markets. Yet critics within China caution against instrumentalizing ethics. Intellectual Yu Keping warns that reducing ethical discourse to state propaganda undermines moral legitimacy. He cites public distrust in opaque governance and the erosion of public

discourse—symptoms of an ethics performative disconnected from lived experience. For Yu, genuine ethical renewal requires space for pluralism, not top-down moral engineering. Western analysts offer further nuance. Political theorist Martha Nussbaum, while critical of China’s human rights record, acknowledges Pohl’s insight into relational ethics—arguing that Confucian notions of reciprocity and community offer valuable perspectives on global justice beyond individual rights. Yet she stresses the need for accountability mechanisms independent of state control. Pohl navigates these debates with intellectual rigor, refusing to romanticize or demonize. He emphasizes that Chinese ethics, like any civilization’s, are contested and evolving—shaped by power, economy, and experience.

Controversies and Risks: The Shadow of Ethical Ambivalence
The most persistent controversy surrounding Chinese ethics

lies in its governance model. Pohl documents how state capacity—built on surveillance, censorship, and administrative control—is justified through ethical narratives of stability and progress. Yet these very tools generate global ethical unease. The export of digital authoritarianism to allies, combined with domestic repression, fuels a perception of China as exporting not just goods, but a competing, authoritarian moral order. Domestically, ethical risks emerge from overcentralization. As party discipline tightens, dissent—even within state institutions—is often suppressed under the guise of “ethical order.” Whistleblowers, journalists, and civil society activists face repercussions, not just for violating laws, but for challenging moral narratives. This creates a paradox: ethical governance dependent on silencing alternative voices weakens long-term legitimacy. Globally, the risk of ethical fragmentation grows. As China deepens technological and geopolitical entanglement, mismatches in ethical expectations—on data rights, labor standards, and transparency—threaten cooperation. Pohl warns of a bifurcating world: one order anchored in Chinese relational ethics and state-led capitalism, another rooted in liberal individualism and rule-based governance. The danger, he argues, is not just conflict, but mutual incomprehension that undermines collective solutions to global challenges like climate change or pandemic resilience.

Global Comparisons: Ethical Pluralism in the Age of Multipolarity

To understand Chinese ethics, one must situate them within a broader global framework. In the West, ethical discourse often centers on universal human rights, individual liberty, and market accountability—principles enshrined in institutions like the UN and OECD. Yet even Western states diverge: Nordic countries emphasize social welfare, while the U.S. prioritizes market freedom and legal individualism. China’s approach diverges sharply from these models. Its ethics emphasize collective responsibility, hierarchical harmony, and state stewardship—values not inherently alien, but prioritized differently. Underpinning this is a Confucian-influenced belief in
