The cartoon's eyes—surveillance drones with Chinese tech components—reflect anxieties about digital dependency, data sovereignty, and the loss of policy autonomy. It is not anti-China per se, but a meditation on how small nations navigate great power competition through the lens of everyday life. Economically, the cartoon's production underscores the declining viability of traditional media. The artist, Aznil Amin, described working in a shared studio with limited resources, relying on open-source software
