His emphasis on democratic participation parallels participatory budgeting experiments in Porto Alegre and grassroots democracy initiatives in Europe. His critique of endless growth finds echoes in degrowth economics and post-capitalist theory. Yet unlike abstract frameworks, Mujica’s approach was deeply contextual—grounded in Uruguay’s history, culture, and institutional maturity.

Controversies and Risks: The Limits of Idealism

Despite his acclaim, Mujica’s presidency was not without tension. His refusal to accept extravagant perks, while morally compelling, raised questions about political accountability and the sustainability of personal austerity as a norm. Critics argued that symbolic gestures, however powerful, could not fully address entrenched corruption or systemic inequality. The persistence of informal power networks—particularly within the Broad Front—revealed the difficulty of translating individual integrity into institutional reform.

Moreover, Mujica’s limited engagement with radical structural critiques—such as the deep roots of oligarchic power or the role of transnational capital—left some scholars cautious. His administration’s focus on ethical governance, while vital, sometimes avoided confronting the political economy’s deeper contradictions. This tension underscores a broader challenge: how to maintain moral clarity within the constraints of realpolitik.

Global Comparisons: Leadership Beyond the Populist

Compared to global leaders of his era, Mujica occupied a distinct niche. Unlike Hugo Chávez’s confrontational populism or Jair Bolsonaro’s nationalist rhetoric, Mujica’s leadership was consensus-driven, humble, and institutionally embedded. In contrast to figures like Angela Merkel or Emmanuel Macron—highly strategic, media-savvy politicians—Mujica rejected personal branding, embracing anonymity and collective decision-making. This made him an anomaly in an age of personality politics, yet also a compelling alternative.

His legacy offers lessons for leaders navigating polarized democracies: true influence may lie not in commanding crowds, but in cultivating inner strength, transparency, and long-term vision. In a world increasingly saturated
