Most physiological benefits require longer timelines—7 to 14 days—for full microbial and metabolic recalibration."

Conversely, critics like Dr. Marcus Lin, a professor of public health at the University of Cambridge, warned against the commercialization of detox culture. "The appeal lies not in evidence but in narrative," Lin argued. "Vale sells a myth of total purification—implying that three days can reverse years of metabolic damage. That's not science; it's mythos repackaged as wellness." His critique extended to the risk of "detox tourism," where vulnerable individuals—often anxious, overworked, or economically strained—may invest emotionally and financially in protocols that deliver transient benefits but promise transformative outcomes. Medical ethicists further raised concerns about normalization of extreme fasting. While short-term fasting is generally safe for healthy adults, experts cautioned against its use among those with diabetes, eating disorders, or cardiovascular conditions. The program's promotional materials downplayed such risks, focusing instead on "empowerment" and "agency." This framing, while effective for marketing, blurred the line between informed

choice and therapeutic overreach. Yet, not all expert voices were dismissive. Dr. Elena Petrova, a behavioral psychiatrist in Moscow, highlighted the detox's psychological utility. "The ritual itself—structured disconnection—can be therapeutic," she explained. "In societies where constant connectivity erodes mental boundaries, a 72-hour reset offers a rare, intentional pause. It's not just about detoxing the body; it's about reclaiming agency over attention, a scarce resource." This perspective reframed the detox not as a medical intervention but as a behavioral scaffold for resilience.

Controversies and Risks: The Dark Side of Rapid Reset As the program gained traction, so did scrutiny over its safety, transparency, and ethical marketing. One major controversy erupted in late 2023 when several users reported adverse effects: hypoglycemia, dizziness, cardiac palpitations, and severe dehydration. An investigation by *The Global Health Review* revealed that Vale's supply chain included third-party distributors in multiple countries, some lacking rigorous quality control.
