These adaptations were not dilutions; they were acts of resistance, reclaiming spiritual autonomy in a world that sought to erase it. The 1950s and 1960s brought independence, yet also civil war (1967–1970), which disrupted communities but intensified cultural introspection. During this period, the Cac Yoruba hymn became a symbol of Yoruba unity amid national

fragmentation. Choirs and *gèlérù* (traditional dance troupes) performed hymns at independence celebrations, redefining them as civic anthems that honored heritage while embracing progress. This era also saw the rise of recording technology, allowing hymns to be preserved and disseminated beyond oral transmission—transforming ephemeral sound into enduring cultural property.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: From Rural Roots to Global Stage

The post-independence economic landscape—marked by oil wealth, structural adjustment, and youth migration—shaped the hymn’s trajectory. In the 1970s and 1980s, economic hardship fueled a revival of traditional arts, as communities sought spiritual and cultural anchors. The Cac Yoruba hymn, now increasingly performed at *ìwò* (spiritual gatherings) and *Àwòkò* (cultural festivals), became a marker of Yoruba economic agency: a cultural export that generated income through tourism, recording sales, and diaspora engagement. Nigeria’s oil economy and regional instability—particularly in the Niger Delta—intensified ethnic consciousness, and the Cac Yoruba hymn became a focal point of this revival. By the 1990s, Yoruba cultural institutions, such as the Ile-Ife Institute of African Languages and Cultures, institutionalized hymn preservation through archives, workshops, and academic curricula. This shift from oral transmission to formal documentation marked a critical evolution: the hymn was no longer confined to ritual spaces but entered the public sphere as a national heritage asset. Globally, the Cac Yoruba hymn’s reach expanded through the Yoruba diaspora—particularly in the Americas, where Yoruba-derived religions like Santería, Candomblé, and Lucumí carry its melodic DNA. In Cuba, Brazil, and the United States, these traditions absorbed Yoruba rhythms and vocal phrasing, embedding the Cac Yoruba hymn into transatlantic cultural networks. Economically, this global resonance has spurred a niche industry: spiritual tourism, music festivals, and digital streaming platforms now monetize these sacred sounds, blurring lines between devotion and commerce.

Industry Impact: From Temple to Global Marketplace

The commercialization of the Cac Yoruba hymn has transformed its production and consumption. Traditional *dùndún* ensembles now collaborate with contemporary producers, fusing ancient chants with electronic beats and hip-hop cadences. Artists such as King Sunny Ade and Ayinde Barrister, though primarily known for secular music, have incorporated hymn-like structures into their work, signaling a broader cultural reclamation. Meanwhile, recording labels like *Orin Atọ* and *Yoruba Roots Music* specialize in archival reissues and new compositions, positioning the hymn as both heritage and marketable art. This industry growth has not been without tension.
