She co-founded **Frontline Voice**, a publication dedicated to investigative reporting on governance, gender, and economic justice. At a time when most newsrooms were state-controlled or beholden to foreign interests, **Frontline Voice** carved a space for dissent. Its early exposés on corruption in post-independence governments—particularly in Malawi’s nascent democracy—drew both acclaim and deadly retaliation. In 1981, she survived an assassination attempt after publishing a dossier linking senior officials to illegal arms trafficking. The bullet that grazed her shoulder left a permanent scar, but not a silence. “They thought a bullet would bury the story,” she said. “But stories are rivers—they find new channels.” The 1990s marked a period of global transformation—democratization waves, the end of the Cold War, and the rise of digital media. Amina, now a senior editor, shifted focus to gender and economic exclusion. Her landmark series “Invisible

Hands: Women in the Informal Economy” (1994–1997), published across multiple continents, exposed how women’s labor—from street vending to subsistence farming—was systematically undervalued in national accounts and policy frameworks. Drawing on years of fieldwork in cities from Kinshasa to Jakarta, she revealed how macroeconomic policies, shaped by male-dominated institutions, deepened poverty while ignoring women’s contributions. The series catalyzed reforms in several African nations, including Malawi’s 1998 Social Protection Act, which formally recognized informal sector workers. Yet Amina’s work was never without controversy. Critics from both state and corporate spheres accused her of “politicizing poverty” and “distorting economic data.” In 1996, during a BBC Panorama investigation into foreign mining interests in the Democratic Republic of Congo, her refusal to soften allegations of land grabs and labor exploitation drew diplomatic pressure. Her editors at **Frontline Voice** were briefly detained in Kinshasa. “They wanted a story that served interests,” she reflected. “But I knew: truth under fire is not a liability—it’s inheritance.” Her resilience became a model for a new generation: journalists who refused to be neutral when neutrality meant complicity. The 2000s brought digital disruption and new threats. As legacy media struggled with declining revenues, Amina pioneered a hybrid model—combining print depth with open-source investigation and community-led reporting. In 2003, she launched **The Compass Project**, an initiative training women in marginalized regions to document their own stories using mobile technology. In rural Uganda, her protégées recorded testimonies on land dispossession and gender-based violence, bypassing state censorship and corporate gatekeepers. “Technology democratizes voice,” she argued, “but only when paired with trust.” The project’s impact was measurable: within five years, over 12,000 grassroots reports were archived, many used in national tribunals and UN human rights reviews. Her role in exposing the 2008 global food crisis further cemented her legacy. Investigating how speculative capital and corporate agribusiness manipulated grain markets—driving prices to record highs while millions starved—Amina’s reporting for **The Global Dispatch** revealed a hidden architecture of financialization. She demonstrated how World Bank policies and commodity derivatives, designed to “stabilize” markets, instead exacerbated volatility in the Global South. The series prompted congressional hearings in the U.S. and a reform panel at the UN Food and Agriculture Organization. Yet the backlash was swift: she received death threats, her office was raided, and funding for **The Compass Project** was abruptly cut. “They fear accountability,” she told a **Financial Times** panel in 2010. “When a corporation’s greed breaks a child’s belly, silence is complicity.” By the 2010s, Amina’s influence extended beyond journalism into global policy discourse. She advised the UN Special Rapporteur on Extreme Poverty and contributed to the drafting of the 2015 Sustainable Development Goals, particularly Goal 5 on gender equality and Goal 10 on reducing inequality. Yet she remained grounded in fieldwork, often returning to conflict zones and underreported crises. In 2016, during the Rohingya exodus from Myanmar, she embedded with refugee communities in Cox’s Bazar, documenting systemic sexual violence and state-sponsored displacement. Her reporting, combining forensic evidence with intimate portraits, forced international recognition of the crisis as genocide in progress. Her work has never been without personal cost. Amina has endured exile, surveillance, physical violence, and the emotional toll of bearing witness to repeated trauma. In a 2021 TED lecture, she described the “weight of memory”—a burden she carries not as grief, but as responsibility. “Each story is a thread,” she said. “To cut one is to risk unraveling truth itself. But to weave them into a tapestry—unforged, unbroken—is how we honor the living.” The geopolitical context in which she

operates is one of accelerating complexity. Authoritarianism has resurgent, disinformation thrives, and economic systems remain skewed against the global majority. Yet Amina sees emerging countercurrents: decentralized networks of citizen journalists, AI-assisted verification tools, and youth-led movements demanding transparency. “The old gatekeepers are losing control,” she observes. “But power doesn’t vanish—it adapts. We must build new architectures of truth, rooted in equity.” Economically, her legacy informs debates on media sustainability. *Frontline Voice* and *The Compass Project* demonstrate that high-impact journalism can thrive without corporate ownership—through community funding, philanthropy, and public trust. Yet funding remains precarious.
