The Robbins Grey’s Anatomy Building, despite its progressive branding, has faced sustained critique for its historical reliance on such models—models that, while scientifically useful, risk erasing the anatomical diversity of women, people of color, and non-conforming bodies. In response, the institution launched the “Anatomy Reclaimed” initiative in 2018—a multi-year, \$12 million effort to diversify its teaching materials. This included commissioning new cadaver specimens from underrepresented populations, integrating 3D scans from global donors, and partnering with community organizations to develop inclusive curricula. For example, a landmark collaboration with the Phoenix Indigenous Health Collective led to the inclusion of Native American anatomical references, acknowledging traditional knowledge systems about the body’s spiritual and physical interconnectedness. Experts have lauded these efforts as a necessary corrective. Dr. Amina Khalil, a medical anthropologist at the University of Arizona, argues: “Anatomy is not neutral. To teach it without confront
