However, lifecycle analyses reveal complexities—land use change, water intensity, and competition with food crops complicate their sustainability narratives. Cellular respiration, too, finds industrial expression. Microbial fermentation, powered by respiratory metabolism, produces everything from biofuels to pharmaceuticals. Companies like LanzaTech ferment industrial waste gases via engineered microbes, turning CO_2 emissions into ethanol using respiratory pathways adapted for efficiency. The Inflation Reduction Act allocates billions to clean energy, but agricultural subsidies continue to favor corn ethanol over next-gen biofuels. This tension reflects a broader societal debate: can photosynthesis-driven transitions reconcile economic growth with ecological limits?
