Yet this

institutionalization carries inherent tensions. The standardization embedded in answer keys risks oversimplifying design's inherently ambiguous and contested nature. This correlation has spurred demand for curricula that produce "T-shaped" professionals—deeply specialized in design methods yet broadly literate in technology, business, and ethics.
