alignment. Sociologist Dr. Amara Nkosi notes: “Franklin doesn’t just demand change; he asks listeners to reimagine their relationship to power, pain, and purpose. That’s why his sermons endure—they don’t offer easy answers, but they reframe the question itself.” His use of metaphor—comparing systemic racism to a spiritual plague, economic inequality to a profane idolatry—transforms abstract injustice into a moral crisis demanding both collective and personal reckoning.
