State governments, often competing for national visibility, invest in exam infrastructure to showcase developmental progress. For instance, during the 2014–2019 NDA government, Hindi-speaking states like Uttar Pradesh and Bihar saw aggressive expansion of exam centers, framed as part of a broader “inclusive growth” narrative. Conversely, regions with lower administrative capacity—such as parts of northeast India or conflict-affected Jammu and Kashmir—experience chronic under-resourcing, leading to irregular exam schedules and inadequate facilities. This uneven distribution has profound implications. In states with robust exam networks, families perceive greater stability and future prospects, reinforcing political loyalty. Conversely, repeated disruptions in exam access—whether due to monsoon floods or bureaucratic delays—can fuel disillusionment, especially among youth. A 2021 study by the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies found that in districts with unreliable exam centers, voter turnout in youth demographics dropped by 12–15% during assessment periods, suggesting a tangible link between infrastructure and civic engagement. Private sector involvement further complicates the landscape. Companies like Infosys and Tata Consultancy Services, recognizing the public demand for secure assessment, have entered into public-private partnerships (PPPs) to supply digital proctoring software and cybersecurity frameworks. While this injects innovation, it raises questions about equity: wealthier districts adopt cutting-edge tools, while poorer ones remain tethered to paper-based systems. The result is a bifurcated experience—where assessment quality, and by extension, perceived fairness, varies sharply by region and class.
