Legal scholars like Professor Nisha Kapoor emphasize institutional failure as a core flaw. "Environmental clearances under the Environment Protection Act are routinely fast-tracked, with limited public scrutiny," she notes. "Independent oversight is weak, and enforcement is sporadic.
