Cybersecurity risks to training networks, data integrity in performance analytics, and the digital divide between veteran and new recruits have emerged as critical concerns. Moreover, the reliance on advanced simulation tools demands continuous investment in infrastructure and instructor training—challenges amplified by supply chain disruptions and

personnel shortages in technical fields. The 2023 graduation thus represents a convergence of traditional discipline and cutting-edge pedagogy, where the human element of leadership and adaptability remains paramount amid rapid technological change.
