Amy's diary entries, published post-disappearance, were read as a direct engagement with the 24-hour news cycle's demand for spectacle and confession. Her diary became a metaphor for the way trauma is consumed and commodified online—where authenticity

is performative, and truth is fragmented across platforms. The novel thus anticipated the era of “fake news” and deepfakes, where identity and reality are increasingly mediated through digital layers
