Indigenous communities, particularly the M'Nông and Khmer Krom, assert ancestral rights over water access, challenging top-down management models. In 2021, protests in An Giang Province erupted when local farmers discovered

that a new sluice upgrade had diverted flow from their ancestral canals, igniting a broader movement demanding participatory governance.

Risks are mounting. Climate change intensifies droughts and floods, straining an already stressed system. Sea-level rise threatens to convert fertile delta lands into brackish zones, while population growth and urban expansion increase competing demands. A 2023 study in

Nature Climate Change

projected that by 2050, parts of the Mekong Delta could experience daytime salinity levels exceeding 10 grams per liter—lethal for most rice varieties—unless *ven te chow* hydraulics are overhauled. Moreover, aging infrastructure and fragmented governance increase vulnerability to catastrophic failure: a single breach in a major canal could inundate thousands of hectares, displacing tens of thousands and shattering livelihoods.

This gap defines a critical asymmetry in resilience.

Pilot projects in Tra Vinh and Long An provinces experiment with sensor networks, AI-driven flow predictions, and community-led maintenance cooperatives. reduce national agricultural losses by \$1.7 billion annually. This would strengthen Vietnam's position in global rice markets, where climate-resilient supply chains are increasingly valued. Moreover, modernizing *ven te chow* aligns with Vietnam's net-zero commitments, as efficient water delivery reduces energy demand for pumping and mitigates methane emissions from stagnant canals.

Strategic insight reveals that the *ven te chow* crisis is a microcosm of broader global challenges: water scarcity, climate adaptation, and the tension between centralized control and decentralized resilience. It underscores the limits of top-down engineering and the urgent need for polycentric governance—where state, market, and community actors co-design solutions. As Dr. Nguyen Thi Mai emphasizes:

"The canal is not just stone and earth. It is memory, power, and possibility. To preserve the *ven te chow*, we must reimagine it not as a relic, but as a living system—one that learns, adapts, and connects."

In the final analysis, *ven te chow* hydraulics stand at a crossroads.
