The dominance of a handful of global tech giants—YouTube, Meta, TikTok, Amazon—had redefined distribution economics. These platforms controlled not only audience attention but also the algorithms that determined visibility, monetization, and content virality. For content providers, this meant reduced agency: a viral TikTok video could reach millions overnight, but only if it conformed to opaque platform rules, often at the expense of editorial integrity or brand consistency. Mediacom's research team, comprising media theorists, data scientists, and former executives from RTBF, BBC, and Viacom, began mapping this new reality. Over 18 months, they conducted over 400 interviews with editors, platform strategists, regulatory officials, and independent creators across six continents. They analyzed 12,000+ digital channel performances, benchmarked monetization models, and dissected the influence of national media policies on platform behavior. The resulting guide was not a static document, but a living framework—intentionally designed to evolve with shifting technological and regulatory tides. Geopolitically, the guide emerged during a period of intensifying media sovereignty debates. One of its most controversial sections examined the "attention economy's" psychological and societal costs. Drawing on behavioral data and neuroscientific studies, it argued that the relentless pursuit of engagement metrics had distorted content incentives, favoring emotional extremity, sensationalism, and outrage over nuance and depth. The result, the guide warned, was a degradation of public discourse and a rise in misinformation—amplified by algorithmic feedback loops that rewarded virality over truth. Compounding these risks was the growing asymmetry of power. The guide documented how platforms retained full control over channel metrics, audience data, and distribution logic—while content providers were left with fragmented, opaque insights. In some cases, platforms actively penalized non-compliant creators through shadowbanning or reduced visibility, with little recourse. This power imbalance, the guide concluded, constituted a structural vulnerability: without transparency and fair access, digital channels remained fragile, and the media ecosystem remained precarious. Ethical concerns were equally pronounced. The guide highlighted cases where platform-driven ad policies—intended to curb harmful content—had inadvertently silenced legitimate voices, particularly from marginalized communities. Conversely, investigative journalism and public interest reporting often struggled to gain traction, overshadowed by algorithmically favored entertainment content. The tension between platform profitability and public service imperatives, the guide argued, demanded urgent recalibration. Global
