In response, civil society groups like Access Now and the Electronic Frontier Foundation (EFF) began advocating for “critical test freedom” as a countermeasure—arguing that certain tests, especially those used in national security or law enforcement, should remain under public or judicial oversight. Yet, these systems often relied on proprietary algorithms with no public audit trail, creating a paradox: innovation marketed as liberation, yet dependent on black-box validation. The right to question how a system works is not a technical flaw—it’s a democratic imperative. To refuse audit is to claim authority over truth itself.” Her research highlights how marginalized groups often bear the brunt of untested systems, facing automated exclusion without recourse. Legal experts, too, are divided.
