CTT’s strength lies in its hybrid identity: neither purely national nor wholly global, but a networked platform that balances standardization with localization. This flexibility has allowed it to thrive in diverse regulatory and cultural environments—from Latin America’s decentralized education systems to Southeast Asia’s centralized digital transformation programs.
