These upheavals exposed deep fractures in societal trust, particularly in institutions—religious, political, and corporate. Goodall observed that while religious adherence declined in traditional forms, spiritual longing persisted, often reconfigured through new media. He saw an opportunity: to use documentary filmmaking—not as evangelism, but as diagnostic tools—to explore how sacred narratives could re-engage a fragmented world. His research drew from theology, media archaeology, and anthropology, synthesizing centuries of religious thought with contemporary media theory. The result was a hybrid project: part ethnography, part philosophical inquiry, part cinematic essay. Evolution: From Concept to Multimodal Epic

The development of **The Lord Is My Shepherd** was marked by iterative refinement. Initially conceived as a short series, it expanded into a six-part, 14-hour epic due to the depth of material uncovered. Goodall traveled to 17 countries, including Jerusalem, Rome, Istanbul, Cape Town, Kyoto, and London, interviewing theologians, musicians, survivors of conflict, and ordinary believers. He embedded himself in monastic communities, attended clandestine worship services in post-Soviet Russia, and recorded live performances of Gregorian chant, Gregorian polyphony, and indigenous chants, treating music as a vessel of memory and transcendence. A pivotal moment occurred during a 2019 visit to the Syrian Orthodox Monastery of Mar Elia, where Goodall witnessed a liturgical service surviving amid civil war. The monks continued their ancient rites not out of political defiance, but as an act of ontological resistance—affirming continuity in a world of rupture. This moment crystallized a central thesis: faith, when expressed through ritual and narrative, becomes a form of cultural

resilience. The series thus wove personal testimony with historical context, juxtaposing medieval chant with contemporary protest songs, psalmody with electronic meditation, to illustrate continuity and rupture. The production incorporated cutting-edge sound design—acoustic field recordings, binaural audio, and spatialized compositions—to immerse viewers in the sensory depth of sacred space. Goodall collaborated with composers like Arvo Pärt and Arvo Pärt-inspired artists, using minimalist motifs to evoke the ineffable. The narrative structure avoided chronology; instead, it moved through thematic nodes: “Call,” “Crisis,” “Ritual,” “Silence,” “Renewal,” each anchored by a musical or literary artifact. This non-linear approach mirrored the cyclical nature of spiritual experience, challenging viewers to perceive faith not as a fixed doctrine but as a dynamic process.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: Faith in the Age of Polarization

The series premiered in 2022, a year defined by overlapping crises: the war in Ukraine, the Taliban’s reassertion in Afghanistan, democratic backsliding, climate collapse, and a post-pandemic recalibration of social trust. In this context, **The Lord Is My Shepherd** resonated as a counter-narrative to both ideological extremism and nihilistic individualism. Goodall’s framing positioned spirituality not as escapism, but as a critical lens through which to interpret suffering and hope. Economically, the project emerged during a transformative period in global media. Traditional broadcast models were faltering; audiences fragmented across platforms. Goodall’s production, backed by the BBC but distributed through independent channels—Netflix, public radio partnerships, and academic networks—reflected a hybrid model: leveraging public service infrastructure while embracing digital reach. This strategy underscored a deeper shift: the convergence of journalistic integrity with cultural curation, where documentary serves not only to inform but to re-enchant. The geopolitical dimension was explicit. Goodall included interviews with religious leaders from contested regions: a Coptic priest in Cairo, a Buddhist monk in Myanmar, a Jewish cantor in Berlin. Their stories revealed how faith communities navigate authoritarianism, sectarian violence, and migration. In Ukraine, a Ukrainian Orthodox liturgy performed in Kyiv’s buried cathedral became a symbol of spiritual endurance. In Palestine, a Sufi whirling ceremony in Hebron illustrated the coexistence of mysticism and trauma. These scenes were not exoticized; they were presented as living testimonies to faith’s role in sustaining communities under duress. Goodall’s critique extended to the commodification of spirituality in Western consumer culture—yoga studios, mindfulness apps, “spiritual but not religious” branding—arguing that such trends diluted religious depth. He positioned **The Lord Is My Shepherd** as a corrective: a return to tradition not through nostalgia, but through critical engagement, emphasizing liturgy’s communal, historical, and ethical dimensions.

Industry Impact: Redefining Documentary and Public Intellectualism

The series disrupted conventional documentary paradigms. Where many faith-based projects emphasize personal piety or denominational promotion, Goodall’s work adopted a secular intellectual rigor, inviting skepticism and dialogue. It was praised by **The Guardian** as “a cinematic sermon for the skeptic,” and by **The Economist** for its “nuanced architecture of belief.” Its success prompted a wave of similar projects—**The Book of Hours** (2023), **Sacred Sounds** (2024)—though few matched its interdisciplinary ambition. For journalism, **The Lord Is My Shepherd** exemplified a new model: long-form, cross-platform storytelling that transcends news cycles. By integrating music, history, theology, and field reporting, it

demonstrated how investigative depth can coexist with aesthetic innovation. Newsrooms began reassessing the role of cultural criticism as essential journalism, particularly in an era of misinformation. The series also challenged the boundary between public intellectual and media performer—Goodall’s accessible yet erudite voice bridged academic and popular audiences, reinforcing the relevance of deep inquiry in public life. However, the project faced criticism from both secularists and religious traditionalists. Secular critics argued it indulged spiritual sentimentality; conservative theologians questioned its ecumenical tone. Goodall captures this globally.” Psychologists echoed this insight. Dr. Elena Vasiliev, a cognitive scientist at Cambridge, cited the series’ power to activate mirror neurons and emotional resonance through music: “The binaural recordings don’t just sound immersive—they simulate presence, fostering a visceral connection to the sacred. This explains why audiences report transformative experiences.” Media scholars, including Dr. Ananya Rao at MIT, highlighted its role in “reclaiming narrative authority.” In an age of algorithmic content, Goodall’s work modeled how deep storytelling can restore complexity and empathy. **Controversies and Risks: Faith, Power, and Representation**

The series was not without controversy. In 2023, a Muslim commentator criticized the inclusion of Quranic recitation without comparative context, arguing it privileged Christian liturgy. Goodall responded by commissioning a parallel episode on Sufi devotional practices, expanding the narrative to include interfaith dialogue. This collaboration—recorded in Istanbul and Lahore—was widely praised as a model of inclusive storytelling. Another risk lay in the potential instrumentalization of faith.
