The early 2000s saw a global surge in evangelical activism, especially in the Global South, where women’s religious leadership faced both opportunity and peril. In Nigeria, South Korea, and India, women such as Comfort Apomah and Leah Schumacher carved spaces in theological education and media, often navigating conservative pushback. Moore’s work, though rooted in American evangelicalism, resonated across these contexts because it addressed universal tensions: the dissonance between sacred texts and gendered power, the struggle for authentic spiritual authority, and the demand for accountability in religious communities. Economically, Moore emerged during a transformation in faith-based publishing. The late 20th century saw religious media shift from print dominance to digital convergence. Moore’s transition from cassette studies to podcasts and online courses mirrored this shift. In an era of cancel culture and performative outrage, Moore's resilience underscored a different kind of authority: one earned through sustained dialogue, not polemic.

Theological scholars have long debated Moore's hermeneutical approach. Dr. Elizabeth Johnson, Jesuit theologian and feminist scholar, notes: “Beth Moore doesn't simply interpret Scripture—she rehumanizes it. Financially, the shift required reinvention. Moore launched an independent media platform, funded through subscriptions and donations—bypassing traditional publishers. While this offered creative freedom, it also demanded new competencies: digital marketing, donor engagement, and direct audience cultivation. The success of this transition—evidenced by sustained listener growth and book sales—signals a broader trend: the decentralization of religious authority and the rise of leader-as-entrepreneur.

Moore's voice—privileged by access to digital platforms, institutional backing, and a relatively open evangelical ecosystem—differs markedly from these contexts, where women often lead underground or in marginalized networks. Yet Moore's emphasis on personal testimony and scriptural intimacy resonates across borders. In Nigeria, female pastors use podcasts and social media to teach Bible study, mirroring Moore's model.
