This has strengthened Taiwan's reputation as a secure, high-integrity hub in AI hardware ecosystems.
- **Balance dual-use risks**: The form enables targeted restrictions—such as blocking exports to entities linked to military AI projects—without broad embargoes that could cripple the broader semiconductor export economy. Yet the mechanism also introduces friction. Compliance costs have risen for SMEs in Taiwan's AI hardware supply chain, particularly those integrating third-party AI chips into final products. Startups developing AI-powered IoT devices or edge computing systems now face delays and audits, potentially slowing innovation cycles. Industry analysts note a growing divergence: large firms with legal and compliance teams adapt, while smaller players struggle, risking market consolidation.

officials in the Department of Commerce note that Taiwan’s framework aligns closely with emerging U.S. export control philosophies, particularly the “catch-all” provisions targeting dual-use AI technologies. They view the G701 Form as a model for how democratic allies can cooperate on tech governance without direct alignment to U.S. sanctions regimes—offering a calibrated alternative to blanket bans.
