This technique, borrowed from postcolonial filmmakers in India and Algeria, reclaims agency by positioning the past as a living, contested terrain rather than a fixed archive.

The geopolitical stakes intensified after 2014, as Western sanctions and diplomatic isolation began to reshape Russia’s cultural economy. Traditional distribution channels in Europe and North America contracted, forcing regional filmmakers to seek alternatives. Kazakhstan, Turkey, Iran, and Qatar emerged as new partners—markets where Russian-language content could circulate with fewer ideological barriers. This shift was not merely pragmatic; it reoriented Kazan’s cinematic identity toward the broader Islamic and Turkic world, fostering co-productions that blended Slavic narrative structures with Middle Eastern visual and musical idioms. The result was a hybrid aesthetic that defied easy categorization—a cinema of borders, where identity is performed not through purity but negotiation.

Yet this expansion has not shielded Kazan’s directors from domestic

pressures. The Putin era's cultural policy, while promoting "traditional values" and national unity, increasingly demands alignment with state narratives. Independent filmmakers face subtle but persistent pressures: funding delays, festival exclusion, and occasional public scrutiny. The term "Kazan on Directing" itself has become charged—praised by some as a symbol of creative resilience, criticized by others as a veneer masking state co-optation. As filmmaker and activist Rakhman Yuldashev states: "We are not just making movies—we are preserving a way of seeing. In a world that often demands uniformity, *Kazan on Directing* reminds us that truth is always plural."
