The deep ocean is not a frontier to

conquer—it's a shared heritage." In response, the IOC revised its operational doctrine, implementing a "Participatory Stewardship Framework" that embedded host nation scientists in decision-making and allocated 30% of expedition-generated data to regional repositories.
