The key, embedded with RFID tags and tamper-evident seals, allowed access to 17 high-

security doors within the medical wing, including Door 55 (Psychiatric Wing) and Door 78 (Administrative Control Room). The escape was not spontaneous but choreographed. Surveillance timelines show that CCTV feeds were manipulated—cameras in Wing B were reset to offline mode for 23 minutes between 22:14 and 22:37, coinciding with a scheduled system reboot.
