The economic implications are stark. The global market for knowledge management and visualization software is projected to exceed \$50 billion by 2030, dominated by U.S. and Chinese tech giants. Microsoft, with Office 365 and Power BI, and Adobe, with Experience Manager, wield immense influence over how professionals write and visualize. Their tools, embedded in workflows, subtly shape cognitive habits—favoring template-driven output, standardized charts, and algorithmic suggestions. This concentration risks creating a homogenized cognitive landscape, where diverse forms of expression are squeezed into platform-defined norms. Yet, emerging economies are also innovating.
