Moreover, digital access gaps limit its global reach; even with open-access initiatives, bandwidth constraints and language barriers exclude vast populations. Nystrom's response has been to partner with local historians and educators worldwide, co-developing region-specific editions and offline tools—ensuring the Atlas remains a collaborative, rather than extractive, enterprise. Looking forward, the Atlas is evolving into a living platform. Machine learning now enables real-time integration of new archaeological finds, satellite imagery, and linguistic data, allowing it to adapt to emerging scholarship. Future versions will incorporate AI-driven scenario modeling—projecting how ancient irrigation innovations might inform modern water governance, or how historical trade routes could inspire resilient 21st-century supply networks. The project also plans a global citizen science layer, inviting users to contribute oral histories, local maps, and community memories—transforming passive viewers into active contributors to historical knowledge. The Indian Ocean trade, active for over a millennium, connected East Africa, the Arabian Peninsula, South Asia, and Southeast Asia in a web of commodity exchange—spices, textiles, slaves, and ideas. This network operated without centralized states, relying on merchant guilds, shared navigational knowledge, and flexible alliances. Its resilience and adaptability offer lessons for today's supply chains, exposed to climate shocks and geopolitical fragmentation. The Atlas highlights how such networks fostered economic interdependence long before the term existed, creating vulnerabilities (e.g., the 14th-century decline of Swahili cities due to shifting monsoon patterns) that echo in

modern vulnerabilities to climate and conflict.
