negotiation—between efficiency and sustainability, centralization and localization, global integration and national sovereignty. Its future depends on how these tensions are resolved: whether it becomes a tool of homogenization or a platform for pluralistic adaptation.

Contrast this with Elena Marquez, whose work bridges engineering and sustainability. She sees the template as a necessary scaffold—not a constraint. 'It enables us to model performance—thermal, acoustic, even social—before construction begins,' she explains. 'We use it to simulate how a forest floor panel behaves under humidity or how a sound-absorbing ceiling affects acoustics in a concert hall.
