The government’s strategic investment in Hallyu (Korean Wave) amplified local brands into global influencers. Practice books became soft power instruments: their visual grammar, disciplined yet expressive, mirrored the nation’s brand of precision and

aspiration. Chinese consumers, hungry for Korean aesthetics amid domestic market saturation, adopted these books as both educational tools and cultural capital. In India, despite linguistic and climatic differences, English-language practice books found niche audiences among urban professionals seeking alignment with global beauty standards. Meanwhile, in parts of Sub-Saharan Africa and Latin America, localized editions began adapting techniques to diverse skin tones and cultural expressions, signaling a move from mere replication to contextual innovation. Economically, the eye makeup practice book industry reflects a microcosm of digital capitalism's dualities. On one hand, it enables low-barrier entry: indie creators produce digital PDFs and e-books with minimal overhead, democratizing access to professional-grade techniques. Platforms like Instagram and TikTok function as de facto publishers, where viral tutorials drive sales of featured products—creating feedback loops between content and commerce. On the other, the market is increasingly consolidated. Dr. Mei-Ling Chen, a cultural historian at National Taiwan University, argues: 'These books are not neutral manuals. Similarly, beauty economist Amara Dubois of Sciences Po Paris observes: 'The practice book's power lies in its gamification. These moves reflect a broader reckoning within beauty, where sustainability is no longer optional but a competitive necessity. Culturally, the practice book reveals a paradox: it empowers individual creativity while reinforcing global homogenization. In Tokyo, a young woman may study a Korean practitioner's contouring technique, then adapt it with traditional *kawaii* motifs—melding global method with local flair. In Lagos, a makeup artist blends African eye shapes with the precision of Korean tutorials, creating hybrid aesthetics that resist one-size-fits-all narratives. This creative friction suggests a future where the genre evolves beyond imitation into genuine cross-cultural dialogue. Looking ahead, the trajectory of the eye makeup practice book is shaped by three forces: artificial intelligence, decentralized creation, and decolonizing aesthetics. AI-powered personalization could enable real-time, adaptive tutorials that adjust to facial structure, skin

tone, and mood—turning books into living, responsive companions. Meanwhile, platforms like Notion and Canva empower users to remix content, fostering a democratized, community-driven evolution. Yet perhaps most transformative is the growing demand for diversity. The *Chroma Edit* brand, for instance, partnered with Shanghai-based digital artists to create *Lunar Glow* editions—techniques adapted to warmer undertones and traditional facial features, blending Korean methodology

with Chinese cosmetic innovation. India presents a contrasting trajectory. While English-language practice books gained traction in urban centers like Mumbai and Bangalore, the real transformation came from vernacular adaptations. Publishers such as *Viva Beauty India* released Hindi and Tamil editions featuring tutorials rooted in regional aesthetics—using *kohl*-inspired liner, earth-toned palettes, and textures suited to humid climates. These books reflect a decolonizing impulse: reclaiming beauty practices that predate Western influence while integrating contemporary techniques. The result is a hybrid genre that challenges the notion of eye makeup as a Western import, instead framing it as a global language of self-expression. In Latin America, the practice book's reception is shaped by both colonial legacies and vibrant indigenous aesthetics. In Mexico and Brazil, where makeup traditions blend indigenous symbolism with colonial European styles, local creators have reinterpreted eye makeup through pre-Columbian motifs—using symbolic colors like obsidian black or jade green, and incorporating facial markings reminiscent of Maya or Tupi art. These adaptations, often shared via WhatsApp groups and Instagram Reels, signal a reclamation of beauty as a site of cultural memory, not just trend-following. The Middle East, with its high cosmetic expenditure and deeply gendered beauty standards, has seen practice books evolve into luxury lifestyle packages. Brands like *Sulwhasoo* and *MAC*

collaborate with regional influencers to produce tutorials emphasizing dramatic winged liners and metallic finishes, aligning with local preferences for bold expression
