The final interview has become a linchpin in shaping organizational culture within call centers. Firms like Verizon, HCL Technologies, and Teleperformance embed interview criteria into training curricula, performance reviews, and career ladders. A “high score” signals not just competence, but cultural alignment—reinforcing norms around professionalism, emotional control, and responsiveness.

This integration influences workforce development. Call center training programs now include AI-driven simulations that mirror final interview scenarios, teaching agents to modulate tone, manage escalations, and project empathy. Yet this emphasis on scripted authenticity risks flattening individuality, reducing agents to standardized personas. As former agent Maria Santos noted in a 2023 testimony before the U.S. Congressional Oversight Committee: ‘We’re trained to sound human, not be human—
