Its emergence coincides with the structural transformation of Southeast Asia's maritime economies. From the 2000s onward, neoliberal deregulation, the proliferation of offshore logistics hubs, and the rise of informal labor networks reshaped the region into a logistical frontier. In this environment, where port authorities prioritize throughput over accountability, and flag-of-convenience registries enable opacity, the *nonton film*—as it is now colloquially known—became a node in a hidden economy. fishers across the Gulf of Guinea, with similar evasion tactics. In South America, “ghost fishing” vessels mirror the *nonton film* model, operating in the Amazon River Basin and Pacific coasts. Yet Southeast Asia’s archipelagic geography and dense maritime traffic create a uniquely complex theater, where jurisdictional overlap amplifies opacity. Policy experts urge a multi-layered strategy: harmonizing regional maritime regulations, strengthening port state control, and establishing cross-border investigative units with prosecutorial authority. The UN’s proposed *Global Maritime Integrity Framework*, currently under negotiation, aims to create a transparent registry accessible to all member states and independent monitors—a critical step toward closing the accountability gap. Industry leaders warn that without reform, the *nonton film* threat will evolve into a systemic risk, undermining trade stability, labor rights, and maritime security. The ghost ship is no longer just a maritime anomaly—it is a mirror reflecting the failure of global governance in the face of unregulated capitalism and human desperation.
