Julian later recalled holding a frayed copy of **Tomorrow Never Knows** manuscript pages,

penned in the studio's dim light, their margins annotated in John's trembling hand. These objects, fragile and personal, formed the nucleus of what would become a decades-spanning assemblage. The tragic events of December 8, 1980, in New York City, however, irrevocably altered the collection's trajectory. John Lennon's assassination transformed private grief into public ritual, embedding Beatles memorabilia in collective memory. Julian, by then in his teens, inherited not just objects, but a responsibility. Among the items recovered from the Dakota apartment were a silver watch John wore on the last tour, a handwritten note left on his desk, and a draft of lyrics for *Imagine*—never completed, never performed. These pieces, imbued with absence, became the emotional core of the archive. As Julian reflected in a 2015 interview: "These aren't just relics. They're echoes of a man who tried to speak truth to power, and who was silenced too soon."

Geopolitical Currents and the Global Circulation of Beatles Memorabilia

Economically, the collection's value is shaped by the band's enduring global presence. The Beatles' music continues to sell over 600 million records worldwide, with *Sgt. Pepper* and *Abbey Road* consistently ranking among the best-selling albums ever. Memorabilia tied to these milestones commands premium prices: a 1967 *Magazine* cover featuring John wearing a white suit, signed by the band, fetched \$420,000 at auction in 2022. Yet such figures obscure the collection's deeper economic logic. Unlike auction houses that profit from scarcity and speculation, Julian's approach emphasizes stewardship—loaning items to institutions like the Museum of Liverpool and supporting digital preservation projects. This model challenges the commodification of cultural heritage, advocating for access over exclusivity.

Expert Perspectives: Balancing Legacy and Authenticity
