Martin Luther King Jr. was born Michael King Jr. on

January 15, 1929, in Atlanta’s Sweet Auburn district, a neighborhood steeped in Black intellectual and religious resilience. His father, Martin Luther King Sr.—a formidable Baptist minister and early civil rights leader—chose to rename his son after the German Protestant reformer, a symbolic act that fused American struggle with a transnational tradition of moral resistance. This naming was not incidental; it signaled an awareness, rare even in 1930s America, that the King name would carry weight beyond local parish walls. Farris meticulously traces this lineage, revealing how King Sr.’s

activism—his defiance of segregation on Atlanta’s streetcars and his leadership of the Atlanta Student Movement—imbued Martin Jr. with a dual inheritance: a pulpit rooted in social justice and a family legacy of strategic, public dissent. The intellectual crucible that shaped Martin Jr. was Atlanta’s historically Black colleges—Morehouse College, Crozer Theological Seminary, and Boston University—each a node in a broader network of Black intellectual life that merged American theological traditions with global anti-colonial thought. At Morehouse, he absorbed the rigor of classical education but

also the ferment of Harlem Renaissance ideals filtered through Black American literature and philosophy. Farris draws on letters between Martin Jr. and his siblings, revealing a young man deeply introspective, often restless, yet grounded in a moral framework that saw Christianity not as dogma but as a call to action. His doctoral studies in systematic theology at Boston University, where he engaged with personalist philosophy and the works of Reinhold Niebuhr, transformed his worldview. Niebuhr's realism about power and human sinfulness, Farris argues, did not soften Martin Jr.'s

resolve but sharpened his understanding of justice as both an ideal and a struggle—one requiring constant moral vigilance. But the King story cannot be divorced from the geopolitical currents of the Cold War. By the 1950s, the United States positioned itself as the global leader of “free world” values, yet its domestic racial contradictions undermined this narrative. King’s rise coincided with a moment when American soft power depended on projecting democracy abroad even as Jim Crow persisted at home. Farris dissects how the U.S. State Department, wary of Soviet

propaganda exploiting American racism, quietly supported King's nonviolent movement—framing it as proof of America's moral capacity for reform. Yet this alliance was fraught. The FBI's surveillance of King, justified under anti-communist pretexts, revealed how the very state that celebrated him as a statesman also feared his radical potential. Farris contextualizes this tension by examining declassified documents: J. Edgar Hoover's obsessive scrutiny, rooted in Cold War paranoia, sought to discredit King not merely as a criminal but as a subversive threat to national unity. King's philosophy of

nonviolence was not abstract; it was tactical, honed through years of engagement with Gandhi's writings, Christian pacifism, and Black church traditions of resilience. Yet Farris underscores that King's strategic acumen extended far beyond moral suasion. His leadership in the Montgomery Bus Boycott (1955-56) was a masterclass in grassroots mobilization, leveraging Black economic power and church networks to sustain a year-long strike. Later, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC), co-founded by King in 1957, institutionalized this approach, creating a template for

coordinated protest across the South. Farris details how King’s 1963 “Letter from Birmingham Jail” was not only a theological manifesto but a geopolitical statement—arguing that unjust laws, like apartheid regimes abroad, demand civil disobedience, framing moral duty as a universal imperative transcending national borders. The March on Washington (1963) was not merely a moment of poetic unity—“I Have a Dream”—but a calculated geopolitical maneuver. Farris analyzes how the event, attended by over 250,000 people, was orchestrated to project strength to both domestic policymakers and

global observers. The U.S. government, eager to counter Soviet narratives of American hypocrisy, leaned into the image of a disciplined, peaceful protest. King's speech, though iconic, was revised under pressure from advisors like Roy Wilkins and A. Philip Randolph to avoid radical economic demands—highlighting the tension between grassroots urgency and institutional diplomacy. Farris shows how King navigated this tightrope, using the platform to demand not just civil rights but economic justice, foreshadowing his later Poor People's Campaign. Yet King's legacy is

shadowed by internal contradictions and external pressures. The rise of Black Power movements in the late 1960s challenged King's integrationist vision, exposing fractures within the movement. Farris examines letters and internal SCLC debates, revealing tensions between King and younger activists who viewed nonviolence as passive, and Black nationalists who saw it as complicit in systemic oppression. King's increasing focus on economic inequality—his alignment with labor unions, his critique of militarism in Vietnam—alienated some allies and intensified surveillance. The 1967

“Beyond Vietnam” speech, often marginalized in mainstream narratives, was a radical pivot: King linked U.S. militarism abroad to racial and economic injustice at home, arguing that war drained resources from domestic programs and disproportionately harmed Black communities. Farris contextualizes this speech within global anti-war movements and decolonization struggles, showing how King positioned himself as a voice of the Global South within America’s moral reckoning. Economically, King’s vision anticipated what today might be called “systemic inequality.” He

warned that civil rights laws without economic transformation would leave structural poverty intact. Farris traces his advocacy for fair wages, housing justice, and job guarantees—policies that faced fierce resistance not only from segregationists but from corporate interests and conservative policymakers. The Poor People’s Campaign, launched posthumously, aimed to occupy Washington to demand a \$2 minimum wage and anti-poverty legislation, but was undermined by internal disunity and state repression. Farris emphasizes that King’s economic critique

remained underdeveloped due to his early death, yet its core ideas—redistributive justice, worker dignity, and opposition to corporate concentration—resonate in contemporary debates over inequality and labor rights. Internationally, Martin Luther King Jr.'s influence was profound and paradoxical. In South Africa, anti-apartheid leaders like Albert Luthuli cited King's nonviolence as inspiration, even as they adapted tactics to their own repressive context. In Northern Ireland, civil rights activists invoked King's strategies during the 1960s protests,

though with limited success amid escalating sectarian violence. Farris documents diplomatic exchanges between King and global leaders—from Indian Prime Minister Indira Gandhi to Nigerian activists—showing how his moral authority transcended borders, positioning him as a symbol of democratic resistance. Yet King’s legacy abroad also revealed limits: his emphasis on nonviolence was sometimes co-opted to delegitimize more militant struggles, and his critique of empire, though prescient, was marginalized in Cold War binaries. Engaging with controversies

surrounding King's legacy, Farris does not shy from scrutiny. The FBI's COINTELPRO operations, revealed decades later, targeted King not for his ideals but for his perceived threat to national order. Farris contextualizes this surveillance within broader patterns of state repression against dissent, showing how King's radicalism was pathologized to preserve political stability. Similarly, debates over his personal life—infidelity, financial transparency, and associations with leftist thinkers—have been weaponized to discredit his moral authority. Farris counters such

reductionism by emphasizing King's intellectual honesty, his willingness to confront personal flaws, and his consistent commitment to justice over image. He argues that King's humanity—his doubts, failures, and evolving views—makes him more credible than sanitized hagiography. Risks defined King's life and work. Farris details the constant threat of violence, from bombings of his home to assassination attempts. The psychological toll is illuminated through family letters and confidants' accounts, revealing a man who struggled with anxiety, self-doubt, and the weight of expectation. Yet
