Wilson examines how sectors like energy, finance, and technology have shaped—and been shaped by—regulatory frameworks. The Tennessee Valley Authority, initially a New Deal experiment, evolved into a model for public utility innovation, demonstrating how state-led investment could drive regional development. Yet, as fossil fuel lobbies grew in influence, agencies like the Environmental Protection Agency faced persistent political pushback, their authority periodically curtailed by shifting administrations. The financial sector offers a stark case study. The Glass-Steagall Act's repeal in 1999, driven by deregulatory ideology and industry lobbying, dismantled barriers between commercial and investment banking. Wilson argues this decision, while intended to enhance competitiveness, eroded financial stability—culminating in the 2008 crisis. The subsequent Dodd-Frank Act attempted to restore oversight, but Wilson notes its fragmented implementation and ongoing political opposition

reflect deeper structural tensions: the state's capacity to constrain private power in an era of concentrated corporate influence. Technology presents a new frontier. The rise of digital platforms has outpaced regulatory development, challenging traditional notions of antitrust, privacy, and free expression. Wilson identifies a critical gap: institutions built for analog-era markets struggle to govern algorithmic power, data monopolies, and disinformation ecosystems. The absence of a comprehensive federal privacy law, and the inconsistent enforcement of Section 230, exemplify this lag. Yet, recent regulatory proposals—such as the American Innovation and Choice Online Act—signal tentative steps toward reasserting public authority. > The federal government's role in industry is thus a battleground of competing visions: innovation versus stability, growth versus equity, openness versus control. Wilson's analysis reveals institutions not as neutral arbiters, but as contested arenas where economic power is negotiated, constrained, and sometimes subverted.

Expert Perspectives: The Tensions of

Governance in Practice

The 13th edition integrates voices from across the policy spectrum, offering a polyphonic view of institutional dynamics. Legal scholar Cass Sunstein emphasizes the importance of “nudges” and administrative discretion in achieving policy goals without legislative overreach, arguing that bureaucratic expertise enhances democratic responsiveness. Yet, he cautions against bureaucratic overreach, where agencies may prioritize procedural continuity over public interest. Political scientist Arend Lijphart, known for his comparative work on consensus democracies, critiques the American system’s adversarial model,

noting that its majoritarian structure often impedes institutional adaptation. Wilson counters that this friction—between branches, levels of government, and interest groups—serves as a vital safeguard, preventing coercive majoritarianism. The judiciary, in this view, functions as both interpreter and check, though its legitimacy increasingly hinges on perceived independence amid politicized confirmations. Economists like Esther Duflo and Abhijit Banerjee highlight how institutional quality directly affects policy efficacy. Weak regulatory capacity, especially in developing contexts, correlates with higher corruption and lower public trust—parallels Wilson draws to early American federal weakness. In the

U.S., declining civic literacy and eroding trust in institutions threaten not just policy implementation, but the very legitimacy of governance. Industry insiders offer sharper insights. CEOs of major tech firms describe regulatory uncertainty as a critical barrier to innovation, while agricultural and energy executives stress the need for stable policy frameworks to justify long-term investments. These divergent perspectives underscore a central dilemma: institutions must balance flexibility with predictability, responsiveness with durability.

Controversies and Risks: Fragility Beneath the Surface

The 13th edition confronts the most urgent vulnerabilities: polarization, erosion of norms, and institutional capture. Wilson identifies partisan gridlock as a systemic risk, where procedural tools like the filibuster and executive orders are

weaponized, undermining consensus-building. The erosion of norms—such as willingness to accept election outcomes or defer to independent experts—threatens democratic resilience. The January 6 insurrection exemplified how institutional vulnerabilities, once hidden, can rupture public trust and constitutional order. Legal scholars warn of “constitutional erosion” through incremental delegation, where Congress cedes authority to agencies without clear mandates, weakening accountability. The rise of “shadow regulation”—informal standards and enforcement priorities—across agencies further complicates oversight. Wilson notes a growing disconnect between public expectations of transparency and the operational secrecy required in intelligence and national security, creating a legitimacy gap. Economic risks are equally stark. The federal government’s creditworthiness, underpinned by institutional credibility, faces strain from partisan fiscal brinkmanship and unsustainable deficits. While Wilson acknowledges the necessity of deficit spending during crises, he cautions that repeated breaches of fiscal restraint could destabilize global financial confidence. Environmental and climate policy reveals another fault line. Federal institutions,

designed for discrete policy domains, struggle to coordinate across agencies, states, and international commitments. The absence of a unified climate strategy, despite scientific consensus, reflects institutional fragmentation and short-term political cycles overriding long-term planning.

Global Comparisons: A Unique Institutional Trajectory

Compared to peer democracies, the American system exhibits distinctive characteristics shaped by its constitutional design and historical path. Unlike parliamentary systems with fused executive-legislative authority, the U.S. separation of powers creates both checks and gridlock. Germany's stronger federal coordination and Japan's bureaucratic continuity offer contrasts: the former balances regional autonomy with

national cohesion, while the latter maintains stability through elite consensus. In economic regulation, the U.S. leans toward market-driven solutions, with weaker centralized oversight than France or Sweden. Yet, its regulatory agencies—though powerful—operate within a more fragmented federal structure, limiting uniformity. Emerging economies, particularly in East Asia, often achieve rapid policy implementation through centralized technocratic capacity, a model the U.S. has selectively adopted in areas like infrastructure and defense. Wilson’s comparative lens reinforces a sober observation: American institutions are simultaneously
