As public opinion evolves regarding decriminalization and regulation, the societal demand for high-risk profiteering could diminish unless adaptable leaders diversify into other ventures or maintain excessive brutality to sustain control. Thus, the

longevity of dominance depends increasingly not only on operational cunning but also on navigating ideological transformations with agility.
