Among these were the last fluent speakers of Ainu, the oral epics of the Yolngu people, and ceremonial masks from the isolated Nukak tribe. The Cognitive Uniques, the most abstract and controversial, encompassed encrypted knowledge—formulae, cryptographic systems, and esoteric practices—whose loss would sever irreparable links to human ingenuity. These included ancient navigation techniques from Pacific wayfinders, forgotten alchemical manuscripts, and the neural mapping data of individuals with rare cognitive syndromes whose perception altered reality. The inclusion of these categories reflected a growing recognition that extinction is not only biological but epistemological. By the 2020s, the list had become a geopolitical artifact as much as a scientific one. Nations began weaponizing the Uniques: some sought to export or claim symbolic Uniques as national patrimony, others weaponized access to restrict knowledge flow.
