Union representative James Carter, head of the Dallas Truck

Dispatchers Union, cautions: 'Certification is a step forward, but it must include collective bargaining power and fair wages. Without those, training alone won't retain talent.' His advocacy reflects broader concerns about labor equity in an increasingly automated industry.
