In Nigeria, where 70% of the population lacks reliable electricity, the national grid teeters on collapse, sustained only by private diesel generators that plunge communities into noise and pollution. The ghosts here are the workers—electricians, technicians, and unemployed engineers—who maintain a broken system without hope. As one Lagos technician described it: 'We're not fixing a network; we're patching a wound that keeps bleeding.'

In Europe, the ghosts appear differently. The 2022 energy crisis, triggered by Russia's weaponization of gas supplies, exposed the fragility of interdependent grids. Germany's reliance on Russian gas, once framed as efficiency, became a vulnerability when geopolitical tensions turned supply into weaponry. The ghosts of over-dependence linger in the form of delayed diversification and underfunded renewable transitions. These are not invisible—they are the visible cost of strategic myopia.

Water Scarcity and the Specter of Contamination

Water systems, often the lifeblood of cities, have become epicenters of wailing ghosts.
