shops into full-scale religious merchandise, adult entertainment distribution (via Hobby Lobby’s controversial “Family” division), and a vertically integrated supply chain that spanned continents. By 2020, the company operated over 1,000 stores, employed more than 70,000, and sourced products from factories in Bangladesh, Vietnam, Mexico, and China. Yet, with scale came scrutiny—especially around labor practices, tax exemptions tied to religious status, and the integrity of internal compliance systems.
